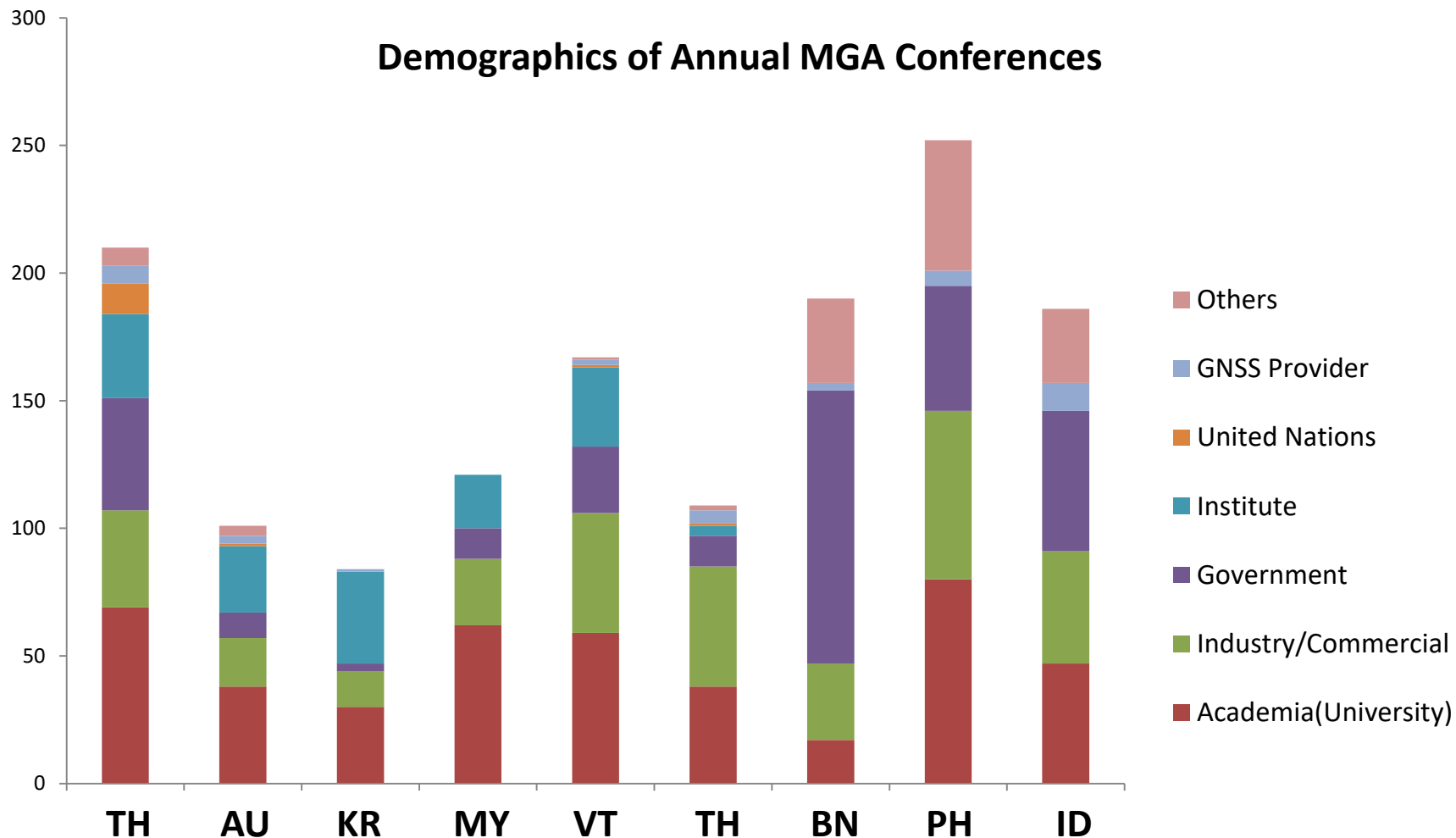

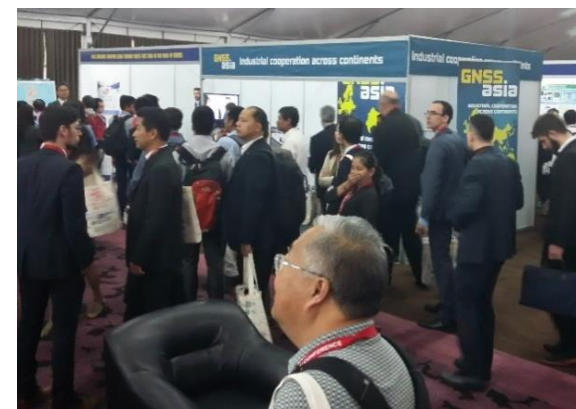
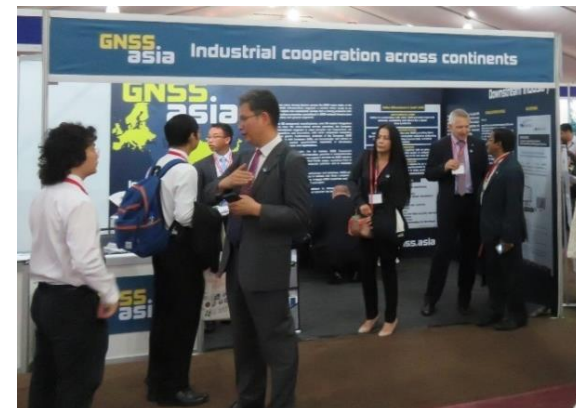

190 participants from universities, research institutes, government agencies, international organizations and companies gathered from **20 countries**.

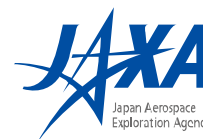

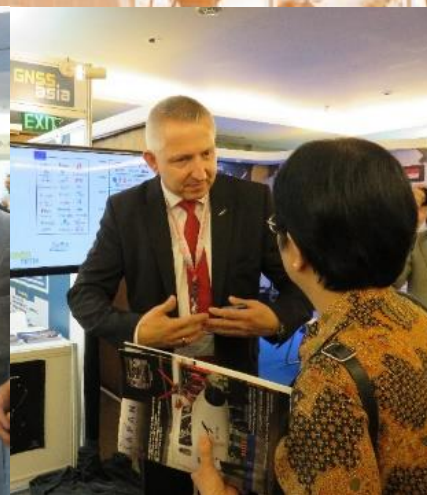
