# African Leadership Conference on Space Science & Technology for Sustainable Development

Review & Outcomes of the 2nd Conference

Pretoria, 2-4 October 2007

## Background of the ALC

First proposed by the Nigerian delegation to COPUOS in 2004.

#### + AIMS:

- → To raise awareness among African leaders of the importance of space science and technology;
- → To provide a regular forum for the exchange of information among African countries;
- → To enhance intra-African cooperation in the development and application of space technology;
- + To strengthen African participation in global space fora.

#### Target Audiences

- national leadership of African countries
- → collective leadership of the African Union (AU) & New Partnership for Africa's Development (NEPAD)
- → African space community

#### + Conferences

- → 1st conference held in Abuja from 23-25 November 2005.
- → 2<sup>nd</sup> conference, held in Pretoria from 2-4 October 2007.
- → 3rd conference will be hosted by Algeria in 2009.

## Participation

- 113 participants from 11 African countries:
  - → Algeria, Congo, Kenya, Lesotho, Mozambique, Nigeria, Rwanda, South Africa, Sudan, Zimbabwe and Zambia.
  - + Five are members of COPUOS.

  - + 4 plenary sessions
  - + 6 parallel sessions
  - + 47 presentations were delivered
  - → Visits to CSIR Satellite Applications Centre and Hartebeesthoek Radio Astronomy Observatory.

- Seek cooperation with African and international intergovernmental organisations
  - + African Union / NEPAD
  - United Nations / OOSA
- Seek cooperation with other regional space conferences
- Work towards implementation of ALC recommendations in future space activities in Africa

#### The ALC and COPUOS

- Seek to align ALC and OOSA activities in Africa (or jointly organised activities)
- → Work towards closer cooperation with OOSA
- → Strengthen coordination & participation of African delegations in COPUOS
- ★ Establish links with African permanent mission in Vienna to raise awareness of space issues and the work of COPUOS

#### Momentum and Continuity

- Steering Committee
  - ★ Will conduct inter-sessional work to implement resolutions and recommendations
    - → Task teams of experts will be established
  - → Representatives of former and future host countries
  - → Representatives of other interested African countries
- + ALC web portal is under development
  - → Links to past & future conferences
  - → Works spaces for ALC action teams
