SUMMARY OF SCHEDULED MEETINGS

976th meeting

Adoption of the Agenda [1]

The provisional agenda A/AC.105/C.2/L.308 was adopted.

Statement by the Chair [2]

The Chair, Mr. Andrzej Misztal of Poland, made an opening statement outlining the work of the Subcommittee.

Organization of work

The Subcommittee decided to invite the representatives of Dominican Republic, Malta and Singapore to participate in the session as observers.

General exchange of views [3]

The Subcommittee began its consideration of this item with statements by the representatives of Egypt on behalf of the Group of 77 and China, Chile on behalf of a group of States, Austria, China, France, Germany, Italy, Indonesia, Japan, Pakistan, Poland and Turkey.

The observers for the European Union, National Space Society and Space Generation Advisory Council also made statements.

977th meeting

Symposium

A symposium organized by the International Institute of Space Law and the European Centre for Space Law on the theme “The Moon Agreement revisited: the road ahead” was held during the 977th meeting of the Legal Subcommittee.

The symposium was co-chaired by Mr. Andrzej Misztal, Chair of the Legal Subcommittee; Mr. Kai-Uwe Schrogl, President of the International Institute of Space Law; and Mr. Sergio Marchisio, Chair of the European Centre for Space Law.
