Indicative schedule of work of the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space at its sixty-second session*

- 1. The schedule of work laid out below is a general guide to the dates and times when agenda items will be addressed during the course of the session. The consideration of all agenda items can be advanced, extended or delayed, depending on the requirements of the members of the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space and any organizational constraints faced during the course of the session.
- 2. The number of statements to be made at each meeting under item4, entitled "General exchange of views", may be limited, as necessary, in order to allow sufficient time for other agenda items to be considered as planned for each meeting. As a general rule, statements should not exceed 10 minutes in duration (A/70/20, para. 357 and A/AC.105/1088, para. 275 (b)).
- 3. Technical presentations should be limited to three per meeting, they should be closely linked to the agenda items of the Committee and they should not exceed 15 minutes in duration. The Chair should remind delegations if that length of time is exceeded (A/70/20, para. 357 and A/AC.105/1088, para. 275 (c)).
