INVITATION CIRCULAR

MEETING ON POSSIBLE FURTHER WORK ON THE LONG-TERM SUSTAINABILITY OF OUTER SPACE ACTIVITIES

At its fifty-sixth session in February 2019, the Scientific and Technical Subcommittee of the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space noted that the delegation of Switzerland would hold a one-day brainstorming session at the expert level with a view to making progress on finding common ground on possible further work on the long-term sustainability of outer space activities (A/AC.105/1202, para. 263).

The Office for Outer Space Affairs informs all Permanent Missions of member States of the Committee and organizations with permanent observer status to the Committee that this meeting has now been arranged and will be held on **11 June in Vienna, Austria, at the Vienna International Centre**. A programme for the meeting has been developed by Switzerland and is attached to this invitation circular.
