Letter dated 3 April 1963 from the Deputy Permanent Representative
of the United States of America addressed to the Secretary-General

In accordance with the provision of Part B, paragraphs 1 and 2 of United Nations General Assembly resolution 1721 (XVI), I enclose registration data concerning objects launched into orbit or beyond by the United States. With these additions and deletions to the record, you will have received for the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space and for the Public Registry a complete registry of all United States space vehicles in orbit or beyond as of 28 February 1963.

In addition, there is included supplemental information concerning a space vehicle launched on 28 February 1963, which did not achieve orbit.
