Letter dated 6 May 1963 from the Permanent Representative of the  
United States of America addressed to the Secretary-General

With reference to the provisions of Part B, paragraphs 1 and 2, of United Nations General Assembly resolution 1721 (XVI), I have the honour to inform Your Excellency that during the period 16 March through 31 March 1963 no objects were launched into orbit or beyond by the United States. All United States vehicles in orbit or beyond as of 15 March 1963 continued to be in orbit or beyond as of 2400Z on 31 March 1963. Therefore, the information submitted to Your Excellency on United States space launches through 15 March comprises a complete registry of all United States vehicles in orbit or beyond as of 31 March 1963.

I enclose data on a United States space vehicle launched on 18 March 1963 which did not achieve orbit.
