Letter dated 2 August 1963 from the Permanent Representative of the United States of America addressed to the Secretary-General

In accordance with the provisions of Part B, paragraphs 1 and 2, of United Nations General Assembly resolution 1721 (XVI), I enclose registration data concerning objects launched into orbit or beyond by the United States which are no longer in orbit. With these additions and deletions to the record Your Excellency will have received for the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space and for the Public Registry a complete registry of all United States space vehicles in orbit or beyond as of 31 May 1963.

In addition there is included information concerning a United States space vehicle launched on 18 May 1963 which achieved orbit but was no longer in orbit as of 2400Z on 31 May 1963.
