Letter dated 7 July 1964 from the Permanent Representative of the  
United States of America addressed to the Secretary-General

With reference to the provisions of Part B, paragraphs 1 and 2, of United Nations General Assembly resolution 1721 (XVI), I have the honour to inform Your Excellency that during the period 1 to 15 May 1964 no objects were launched into orbit or beyond by the United States. Nor were any objects launched by the United States which did not achieve orbit. All United States space vehicles in orbit or beyond on 30 April 1964 continued to be in orbit or beyond as of 2400Z, 15 May 1964. Therefore, the information submitted to Your Excellency on United States space launches through 30 April 1964 comprises a complete registry of all United States space vehicles in orbit or beyond as of 15 May 1964.
