RESOLUTION 1721 B (XVI) BY STATES LAUNCHING
OBJECTS INTO ORBIT OR BEYOND

Letter dated 27 October 1964 from the Permanent Representative of
the United States of America addressed to the Secretary-General

In accordance with the provision of Part B, paragraphs 1 and 2, of United Nations General Assembly Resolution 1721 (XVI), I enclose registration data concerning objects launched into orbit or beyond by the United States. With these additions and this deletion in the record Your Excellency will have received for the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space and for the Public Registry a complete registry of all United States space vehicles in orbit or beyond as of 15 September 1964.

In addition there is included supplemental information concerning a United States space vehicle which was launched on 1 September 1964 but which failed to achieve orbit.
