RESOLUTION 1721 B (XVI) BY STATES LAUNCHING OBJECTS INTO
ORBIT OR BEYOND

Letter dated 24 May 1966 from the Permanent Representative of
the United States of America addressed to the Secretary General

In accordance with the provision of part B, paragraphs 1 and 2, of United Nations General Assembly resolution 1721 (XVI), I enclose registration data concerning objects launched into orbit or beyond by the United States. With these additions and deletions, Your Excellency will have received for the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space and for the Public Registry a complete registry of all United States space vehicles in orbit or beyond as of 28 February 1966.

In addition, there is included supplemental information concerning a United States space vehicle launched on 7 January which did not achieve orbit.
