On 12 March 1972 the sixth satellite (TD-1A) of the European Space Research Organization (ESRO) was launched from the Vandenberg Base in California. Orbital characteristics of the satellite:

perigee:	541 km
apogee:	547 km
orbital period:	97 minutes
inclination:	97.6°
