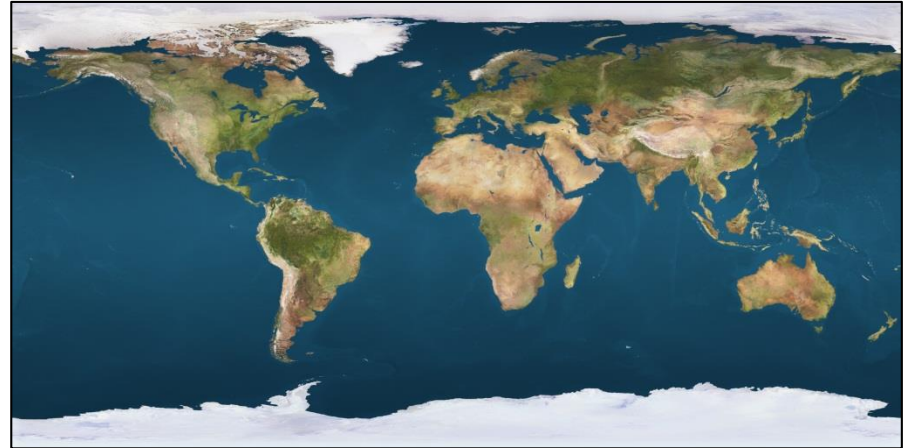

# **PATH FORWARD**

## To summarize

- UNOOSA received more than 150 Responses to the CFI
- From 75 Countries
- All 17 of the SDGs are addressed in the responses
- All possible mission types are addressed
  - Internal Powered Payload – return
  - Internal Powered Payload - no return
  - Internal Unpowered Payload - with return
  - External Powered – no return
  - Satellite Deployment



# The UN/Dream Chaser Mission Current Timeline

- ✓ Sep 2017: Issue Call for Interest (CFI to UN Member States)
- ✓ Nov 2017: CFI responses due
- ✓ Jan 2018: Bidder's briefing
- Plan for 2018:
  - Release of Announcement of Opportunity (AO)
  - AO responses due
- Plan for 2019
  - Payload selections
  - Select landing Site
- Plan for 2022
  - Mission Execution



# What are we doing in the Meantime?

- Finalizing the Announcement of Opportunity to be released in 2018
- Working to identify and secure Launcher and Launch Services
- Working to select the Landing Site
- Putting together an International Review Board that will analyze the responses to the Announcement of Opportunity and select the payloads that will be manifest on board of the first UN/Dream Chaser Orbital Mission
- Working on a preliminary Funding Plan for the mission
