- INTASAT: launched on 15 November 1974 from Vandenberg Air Force Base, California, United States of America
- HISPASAT-1A: launched on 10 September 1992 by Arianespace from Kourou, French Guyana
- HISPASAT-1B: launched on 22 July 1993 by Arianespace from Kourou, French Guyana
- UPM-Sat 1: launched on 7 July 1995 by Arianespace from Kourou, French Guyana
