Summer School Multi-GNSS environment for sustainable development

9 - 13 September 2013

Hoi An, Vietnam

A one-week Summer School entitled "Multi-GNSS environment for sustainable development" will be organized from 9 to 13 September 2013 in Hoi An, Vietnam, a UNESCO world heritage city near Da Nang. The opening will take place the evening of Sunday, 8 September.

The Summer School is part of the activities of G-NAVIS, a project co-funded by the European Union in the FP7 that aims to contribute to the capacity building on global navigation satellite systems (GNSS) and Multi-GNSS technologies in the South East Asian Region. The School is designed for engineers, researchers, technicians, PhD students, public and private decision makers interested in satellite navigation. A minimum working and/or study experience in GNSS related activities is requested.

The activities:

- *Technical sessions*: for attendants with a solid technical knowledge of GNSS.
- Introduction to GNSS: for attendants that are somehow familiar with GNSS related activities, but have less specific background.
- Working groups.
- *Applications* with possible Industry presentations (ITS, maritime, rail, LBS, remote sensing, timing etc.).

"Technical sessions" and "Introduction to GNSS" sessions will be conducted in parallel and attendants have to choose, in the application stage, which group of lectures they are willing to attend.

The total number of attendees will be limited to 25-30 people. The Growing NAVIS Project will fund the participation of one attendant from each ASEAN Member State. In order to enroll to the summer school perspective participants have to fill the on line form available at:
