High-level Panel on Space Exploration

A High-level Panel on Space Exploration, organized by the Office for Outer Space Affairs, will be held *today*, Wednesday, 6 June 2007, in the UN/UNIDO Board Room, at 4:00 p.m., following the adjournment of the 566th meeting of the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space.

The Panel will provide an opportunity for members of the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space to discuss the motivations for and aspects of ongoing and planned space exploration activities, and the possible future role the United Nations system could play in providing a forum for space-faring and space-using countries alike to consider space exploration-related issues. The Panel will be chaired by Mr. Gérard Brachet of France.
