SUMMARY OF SCHEDULED MEETINGS

566th meeting

Opening of the session [1]

The session was opened at its 566th meeting.

Adoption of the agenda [2]

The provisional agenda (A/AC.105/L.267) was adopted.

Organization of work

The Committee decided to invite the representatives of Bolivia, the Dominican Republic, the Holy See, Namibia, Paraguay, Switzerland, and Tunisia to participate in the session as observers.

The Committee also decided to invite the representatives of the African Organization of Cartography and Remote Sensing (AOCRS), the Environmental Women's Assembly (EWA), and the Secure World Foundation (SWF) to participate in the session as observers.

The representative of Chile made a statement.

The Director-General of the United Nations Office at Vienna (UNOV), Mr. Antonio Maria Costa, also made a statement.

Mironov of the Russian Federation, Ms. Mazlan Othman of Malaysia, Mr. B.N. Suresh of India, and Mr. Zhang Wei of China.
