## **SUMMARY OF SCHEDULED MEETINGS**

### **613<sup>th</sup> meeting**

#### *Opening of the session [1]*

The session was opened at its 613<sup>th</sup> meeting.

#### *Adoption of the agenda [2]*

The provisional agenda (A/AC.105/L.276) was adopted.

#### *Election of Officers [3]*

Mr. Dumitru Dorin Prunariu of Romania was elected Chair of the Committee, Ms. Nomfuneko Majaja of South Africa and Mr. Raimundo González Aninat of Chile were elected First Vice-Chair and Second Vice-Chair/Rapporteur, respectively.

#### *Organization of work*

The Committee decided to invite the representatives of Azerbaijan, Costa Rica, Côte d'Ivoire, Dominican Republic, Tunisia, the United Arab Emirates and the Holy See to participate in the session as observers.

The Committee decided to invite the representatives of the International Association for the Advancement of Space Safety (IAASS) and of the Association of Remote Sensing Centers in the Arab World to participate in the session as observers.

#### *Statement by the Chair [4]*

The Chair made a statement outlining the work of the Committee.

*General exchange of views [5]*

The Committee began its consideration of this item with statements by the representatives of Algeria on behalf of the Group of 77 and China, Bolivia (Plurinational State of), Burkina Faso, Costa Rica on behalf of the Latin American and Caribbean Group (GRULAC), Chile, China, Egypt on behalf of the Non-aligned Movement (NAM), Italy, Japan, the Syrian Arab Republic, the United Kingdom, and Zimbabwe on behalf of the African Group.

The observers for Tunisia and the United Arab Emirates also made statements.
