Symposium

A symposium on “Legal implications of space applications for global climate change”, sponsored by the International Institute of Space Law (IISL) and the European Centre for Space Law (ECSL), will be held *today*, Monday, 31 March 2008, in Conference Room III, at 4:00 p.m., following the adjournment of the 766th meeting of the Legal Subcommittee of the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space.
