779th meeting

Status and application of the five United Nations treaties on outer space [6]

The Subcommittee concluded its consideration of this item with the adoption of the report of the Working Group on the status and application of the five United Nations treaties on outer space (A/AC.105/C.2/2008/TRE/L.1).

General exchange of information on national legislation relevant to the peaceful exploration and use of outer space [12]

The Subcommittee concluded its consideration of this item with a statement by the representative of Brazil.

Proposals to the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space for new items to be considered by the Legal Subcommittee at its forty-eighth session [13]

The Subcommittee continued its consideration of this item with statements by the representatives of Greece, Italy, Ukraine, Germany, the United States of America, Chile, China, Japan, the Russian Federation, Colombia, the United Kingdom, France, and Netherlands.

The observers for the European Space Agency (ESA), the International Law Association (ILA), and the International Astronautical Federation (IAF) also made statements.
