**803<sup>rd</sup> meeting**

*Organization of work*

The Subcommittee decided to invite the representative of Israel to participate in the session as observer.

**804<sup>th</sup> meeting**

*Space Law Symposium*

The symposium on the theme of “National space legislation - crafting legal engines for the growth of space activities” that was held during the 804<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Legal Subcommittee, was also organized by the European Centre for Space Law (ECSL).
