Symposium

A scientific symposium on the theme “A new look at the delimitation of airspace and outer space” will be held today, Monday 28 March, 2011, in Room M1, at 3:00 p.m.

The symposium will be co-chaired by the President of the International Institute of Space Law, Tanja Masson-Zwaan, and the President of the European Centre for Space Law, Mr. Sergio Marchisio.

Presentations will be made on the following subjects: A short look back at a long debate; An engineering look at delimitation in light of technological changes; Are there indications for upper and lower limits for airspace and outer space in air law, space law and national legislation?; Legal implications for delimitation of airspace and outer space; Delimitation and the commercial use of outer space; Delimitation as an element for rules of the road. A space traffic management regime.

Concluding remarks will be made by the Chairman of the Legal Subcommittee and by the Chairman of the Working Group on Matters Relating to the Definition and Delimitation of Outer Space of the Legal Subcommittee.
