## **SUMMARY OF SCHEDULED MEETINGS**

820<sup>th</sup> meeting

### *Opening of the session and adoption of the agenda [1]*

The session was opened at its 820<sup>th</sup> meeting.

The provisional agenda (A/AC.105/C.2/L.280) was adopted.

### *Organization of work*

The Chair made an opening statement outlining the work of the Subcommittee.

The Subcommittee decided to invite the representatives of Azerbaijan, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, Israel, the United Arab Emirates and Yemen to participate in the session as observers.

### *General exchange of views [3]*

The Subcommittee began its consideration of this item with statements by the representatives of Austria, China, Colombia on behalf of the GRULAC, the Czech Republic, the Islamic Republic of Iran on behalf of the Group of 77 and China, Japan, Kenya, the Philippines and Romania.

The observers for the International Institute of Space Law and for the International Astronautical Federation made statements.

The Director of the Office for Outer Space Affairs made a statement on the work of the Office.

### **Symposium**

A symposium on the theme of “A new look at the delimitation of airspace and outer space”, co-organized by the International Institute of Space Law (IISL) and the European Centre for Space Law, was held during of the 821<sup>st</sup> meeting of the Legal Subcommittee. The symposium was co-chaired by Ms. Tanja Masson-Zwaan and Mr. Sergio Marchisio.

Presentations were made by Ms. Catherine Doldirina, McGill University, Canada, Mr. Luboš Perek, Learned Society of the Czech Republic, Czech Republic, Mr. Marco Pedrazzi, University of Milan, Italy, Ms. Joanne Gabrynowicz, University of Mississippi, United States of America, Mr. Sang-Myon Rhee, Seoul National University, Republic of Korea and Mr. Jean-François Mayence, Belgian Science Policy Office, Belgium.
