The Subcommittee continued its consideration of this item with statements by the Czech Republic, China, Ecuador, Romania, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Italy, Nigeria, Poland, India, Malaysia, France, Venezuela, and Canada, and the observers of EURISY and the European Organization for Astronomical Research in the Southern Hemisphere (ESO).

An industry symposium on the theme "Space industry in emerging space nations" was held during the 681<sup>st</sup> meeting of the Scientific and Technical Subcommittee of the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space.
