The 21st ECSL Summer Course on Space Law and Policy

The twenty-first edition of the ECSL Summer Course on Space Law and Policy was organized from August 27 to September 8, 2012 in cooperation with the Neapolis University of Pafos, Cyprus. Academic Co-ordinator of the event was Professor Vassilios G. Cassapoglou of Greece. Also, special invited speaker was the Secretary-General of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU), Dr. Hamadoun Touré, first-ever highest executive of a United Nations specialized agency contributing to an ECSL summer course. There were 41 students coming from 14 countries from different parts of the world. The students followed lectures on space law and policy issues given by 24 speakers - either academicians or practitioners specialized in the space field. The Course was completed by an inter-active work on a case study dealing with international space cooperation.

Finally, to the success of the 21st Summer Course also contributed the Joint Greek and Cypriot satellite communications undertaking Hellas-Sat, which organized and sponsored all cultural events.
