Project definition

- Building blocks:
 - Portal to the Universe (idea presented for the first time in the C55 Business Meeting in the IAU GA in Prague)
 - Quantum Diaries → The Universal Times → Cosmic Diary
 - "Connect people with the night sky and to help them become aware of light pollution issues" → Dark Skies Awareness
 - "Arrange a series of live webcasts over a 24-hour period from telescopes around the world." → 100 Hours of Astronomy (Around the World in 80 Telescopes)

- Empower astronomical communities in developing countries.
- Support and improve formal and informal science education.
- Provide a modern image of science and scientists.
- Facilitate new networks and strengthen existing ones.
- Improve the **gender-balanced representation** of scientists at all levels and promote greater involvement by underrepresented minorities in scientific and engineering careers.
