

COMMITTEE ON THE PEACEFUL USES  
OF OUTER SPACEREPORT OF THE BUREAU ON THE ORGANIZATION  
OF THE WORK OF THE COMMITTEE IN 1964

1. In its interim report on the organization of the work of the Committee in 1964 (A/AC.105/16), the Bureau stated that there was agreement among the members that the Legal Sub-Committee would meet at Geneva from 9 to 26 March 1964. It also stated that the Committee should hold one session "in the summer in New York" in order to, among others, consider the reports of its Sub-Committees and of the specialized agencies.
2. At the conclusion of its scheduled session at Geneva on 26 March, the Legal Sub-Committee noted that although substantial progress had been achieved in its work, "there had been insufficient time to draft international agreements". It therefore agreed to resume its session at New York "approximately three weeks before the forthcoming meeting of its parent Committee".
3. In connexion with the foregoing agreement, the officers of the Committee held consultations with all the members with a view to ascertaining their views regarding the programme of work of the Committee in 1964.
4. On the basis of these consultations, and the assumption that the nineteenth regular session of the General Assembly will open on 10 November 1964, members of the Committee have agreed with the following:
  - (i) The resumed session of the Legal Sub-Committee will be held at Headquarters from 5 to 23 October.
  - (ii) The fifth session of the main Committee will be held at Headquarters from 26 October to 6 November.
5. Accordingly, the Secretary-General has been requested to make the necessary administrative arrangements for the resumed session of the Legal Sub-Committee and the fifth session of the Committee.
