INFORMATION FURNISHED UNDER THE CONVENTION ON REGISTRATION
OF OBJECTS LAUNCHED INTO OUTER SPACE

Note verbale dated 7 April 1988 from the Permanent Mission of the Federal Republic of Germany to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

The Permanent Representative of the Federal Republic of Germany to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to paragraph 1 of article II of the 1975 Convention on Registration of Objects Launched into Outer Space, has the honour to inform the Secretary-General that the Federal Republic of Germany maintains a registry of space objects with the Federal Aviation Office in Braunschweig. The registry forms a supplement to the aircraft register. The jurisdiction of the Federal Aviation Office is subject to possible organizational changes in the Federal Republic of Germany about which the Secretary-General will be informed if and when they come to pass.
