General description of the space object:
 Slohsat FLEVO is a technology-demonstration minisatellite for the experimental study of liquid dynamics and liquid management problems in space. After launch, it was operated for 14 days. Slohsat FLEVO is a joint programme between ESA, the Ministry of Economic Affairs of the Netherlands, the Netherlands Agency for Aerospace Programmes (NIVR) and the National Aerospace Laboratory (NLR).
