Building Blocks for the Development of an International Framework for the Governance of Space Resource Activities: A Commentary

Conference Room Paper submitted by Luxembourg and the Netherlands

- 1. In 2019, the The Hague International Space Resources Governance Working Group (the Working Group) adopted the Building Blocks for the Development of an International Framework for the Governance of Space Resource Activities. These have been introduced to COPUOS in 2020, in document A/AC.105/C.2/L.315. Following this adoption, a Commentary to these Building Blocks has been developed. This Commentary was designed to clarify the content of each Building Block, reflecting agreed provisions and suggestions, as accorded by the Working Group, and to provide additional observations to illustrate their raison d'être. Additionally, this action was envisioned as an instrument to present the output of the Working Group to the general public, including information about its mission, composition, phases and procedure, while developing an additional channel of communication with the international community to foster the discussion on the Working Group topics.
