



Information furnished in conformity with the Convention on Registration of Objects Launched into Outer Space

Note verbale dated 21 June 2023 from the Permanent Mission of Belgium to the United Nations (Vienna) addressed to the Secretary-General

The Permanent Mission of Belgium to the United Nations in Vienna has the honour to transmit herewith, on behalf of the Government of Belgium, a notification concerning the registration by Belgium of the space object Gregoire.

The object in question is being registered in accordance with article VIII of the Treaty on Principles Governing the Activities of States in the Exploration and Use of Outer Space, including the Moon and Other Celestial Bodies (General Assembly resolution 2222 (XXI), annex), and pursuant to the provisions of the Convention on Registration of Objects Launched into Outer Space (General Assembly resolution 3235 (XXIX), annex). The present notification is being made in application of the recommendations set out in General Assembly resolution [62/101](#) of 17 December 2007.¹
