**Agenda item 12 : Use of space technology in the United Nations System

Mr. Chair,

Indonesia recognizes the efforts made by UN-System organizations to address global concerns by utilizing space technology and applications. According to it, those steps are necessary to benefit all member nations and to enable the achievement of the SDGs eight years from now.

Indonesia supports UN-Space coordination efforts to increase synergy in discussions and recommendations of important issues using space technology and application. In this regard, we believe that the many UN bodies that have not yet joined as participating organizations may do so in the near future.

In this opportunity, we would like to inform that Indonesia contributes to one of the UN bodies by becoming the host country for UNESCAP last year. The series of activities were held, including:

- (1) The 26th Session of the Intergovernmental Consultative Committee (ICC) on the Regional Space Applications Program for Sustainable Development (RESAP);
- (2) Ad hoc ICC RESAP; and
- (3) The 4<sup>th</sup> Ministerial Conference on Space Application for Sustainable Development.

Maintaining the series of activities in this year, Indonesia also held a side event in the 10<sup>th</sup> Asia-Pacific Forum on Sustainable Development under the theme Future Generation: Multi-Stakeholder Roles for Strengthening Space Applications and Sustainable Development. Indonesia also participated the 79<sup>th</sup> UNESCAP commissions meeting that endorsed Jakarta Ministerial Declaration.
