Preparations of the UN Summit of the Future, scheduled for 22-23 September 2024 in New York, are entering the final phase with the release of a [new draft \(rev.1\)](#) of the Pact for the Future in May 2024. As the [text has been revised](#) to be more concise, ambitious and action-oriented, the side event will provide a final opportunity to update COPUOS delegations on the process and bring a Vienna perspective to the new space-related language of the draft. As a follow-up to the discussions at STSC and LSC, COPUOS Member States from all regional groups as well as observer organisations are once again invited to exchange their ideas and perspectives on the space-related language in the new draft. The exchange may also serve as a forum for Vienna delegations to discuss how to coordinate final contributions to the negotiations in New York.
