Decisions to be taken by the Working Group on the Long-term Sustainability of Outer Space Activities at the 68^h session of the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space

Non-paper by the Chair of the Working Group on the Long-term Sustainability of Outer Space Activities

Note: The below paragraphs reflect decisions that were discussed in the Working Group's informal consultations on 30 June 2025. They will be put forward for formal action by the Working Group in its formal meeting scheduled for the afternoon of 30 June 2025.

- The Working Group agrees that it has reached consensus on the text of its draft final report, as contained in conference room paper (A/AC.105/2025/CRP.33), and that the text of that report will be formally edited and translated into all the official languages of the United Nations following the sixty-eighth session of the Committee.
- 2. The Working Group recommends that, upon its presentation of its draft final report to the Scientific and Technical Subcommittee at the sixty-third session, in 2026, the existing Working Group be extended with the current Chair.
- 3. The Working Group agrees to hold an informal online meeting in September/October 2025 in order to work on drafting its new workplan.
- 4. The Working Group decides to establish an expert group on space situational awareness, as per the proposal contained in conference room paper A/AC.105/2025/CRP.27/Rev.2.
