- ii) Pakistan's nomination is currently serving as the Task Force Coordinator for the Group of 77 & China, Vienna Chapter, since January 2023, as well as the Second Vice Chair and Rapporteur of the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space (COPUOS) since June 2024, possessing the relevant professional and technical experience to undertake the task to facilitate the Action Team in achieving its mandate.
- iii) By swiftly resolving the question of the ATLAC's bureau, focus can correctly return to its substantive mandate with discussions in line with the agreed mandate, driving all delegations to engage constructively and

focused on collecting substantive views in order to achieve the ATLAC's outcome.
