ATLAC Submission: Indonesia

Indonesia wishes to submit its contributions to the discussion regarding Bureau and Workplan of the Action Team on Lunar Activities Consultation (ATLAC), as follows:

1. Regarding the composition of the Bureau, Indonesia would like to propose one Chair and three Vice Chairs.
2. The tasks of the Vice Chairs could be divided into three different areas, namely: technical aspects, utilization, and legal issues. These Vice Chairs should reflect the negotiations in the Scientific and Technical Subcommittee (STSC), the Legal Subcommittee (LSC) and the Committee.
3. Indonesia also proposes that the election of Bureau members reflects the regional balance and the equitable representation of developed and developing countries in COPUOS. Indonesia proposes further that no Chairs and Vice Chairs be from the same regional group.

Indonesia reserves the right to submit more specific proposals in writing and/or to express such proposals at the forthcoming meetings of the Action Team.
