Workplan of the Action Team on Lunar Activities Consultation (ATLAC) (2025–2027/2028)

(To be presented for endorsement at the 68th session of the Committee in 2025)

In accordance with its mandate, ATLAC will pursue focused, expert-level exchanges aimed at developing recommendations to improve consultations related to lunar activities. The work of ATLAC is to be without prejudice to the consultations stipulated in article IX of the Outer Space Treaty and to relevant ongoing efforts within the framework of the Committee and its subcommittees, to promote informal collaboration and mutual exchange of information. Its workplan is structured over three years, from 2025 to 2027, with the possibility of continuation into 2028, if necessary.

2025 – Establishing the workplan

- **Objective:** Define and agree upon a multi-year workplan and identify key priority topics for consultation under the ATLAC mandate.
- **Expected outcome:** Approval of the ATLAC workplan by the Committee at its sixty-eighth session.

2026 - Elaboration of Draft Recommendations

- **Objective:** Conduct focused, expert-level exchanges to develop an initial draft of recommendations to improve consultations related to lunar activities.
- Expected outcome: Consolidated draft recommendations submitted to the Committee.

2027 - Finalization of Recommendations

- **Objective:** Finalize recommendations on consultations related to lunar activities for consideration and possible endorsement by the Committee.
- **Expected outcome:** Endorsement of final recommendations by the Committee at its seventieth session.

[Optional: 2028 – Continuation, if necessary]

If further refinement or additional follow-up is required, ATLAC may continue its work into 2028 and present complementary proposals to the Committee, as foreseen under its mandate.
