Recent progress in Japan

Japan's national space policy commits to encouraging the space resources-related industry and to contributing to fair governance rules on space resources development

- Space resource utilization is added to the schedule of Japanese space policy (2016)
- The Diet passed a collateral resolution about space resources (2016)
- Minister of State for Space Policy, Yosuke Tsuruho expressed the government's intent to engage actively in space resources issues
