



All space actors




Space actors addressing debris




More geographical diversity


All states with space actors




States with actors addressing debris



Of 1,400 actors, 85 focus on debris




Most organizations working on debris are from the USA, Japan, China and France




Private sector outpacing governmental






Explosion in number of new arrangements in last decade




Mostly bilateral arrangements
