Thank You Madam Chair,

Indonesia views that regulatory framework on the peaceful exploration and use of outer space is paramount importance, mainly for States which actively engage in space activities.

Indonesia enacted the Space Law in 2013 and to implement such law, there are some regulations made by the Government. We enacted Presidential Regulation No. 45 of year 2017 on National Master Plan on Space Activities year 2016 – 2040. The National Master Plan takes into account some basic capabilities and the national and international strategic environment. The Master Plan contains the vision and mission, policies, and strategies, including short, medium, and long-term strategic plans.

We also created Government Regulation No. 11 of 2018 on Remote Sensing and Government Regulation No. 7 of 2023 on Mastery of Space Technology.

Indonesia continues to participate and contribute in national space legislation initiative (NSLI) – Asia Pacific regional space agency forum second phase. Indonesia supports and joins submission on the status of National Space Legislation (NSLI) in the Countries of the Asia-Pacific Region, Second Phase to the 66th Session of the UNCOPUOS in 2023.
