Mr. Chairperson,

Since this is the first time that I take the floor, I would like to congratulate you on the chairmanship of this meeting.

The topic under consideration -the definition and delimitation of outer space- is of fundamental importance for the future of space exploration. The growing space activity, both by States and private companies, makes this topic even more complex.

Brazil has a long history of commitment to the peaceful use of outer space and the development of international space law. Therefore, I feel honored in having been appointed to the presidency of the Working Group on the Definition and Delimitation of Outer Space. I am grateful for the trust placed in myself and in my country by member states.

Brazil believes that the Working Group has a crucial role to play in the search for a consensus-based solution to this complex issue. Brazil is confident that with the hard and dedicated work of all members, we can achieve a positive outcome that benefits the entire international space community.
