Agenda Item 17 - Dark and Quiet Skies

Mr Chair, Distinguished Delegates,

Canada appreciates this important topic being on the agenda, for a second time, at this year's STSC.

We recognize the growing low-earth observation utilization and the benefits associated providing

connectivity to remote communities' across Canada and the world as well as new capabilities for

Earth imaging and environmental science.

Canada supports the proposal to extend the temporary Agenda Item on Dark and Quiet Skies as

well as the Establishment of an Expert Group. We believe that this Expert Group will be most

effective if it includes all interested nations, and balanced representation of private satellite

operators, as well as those from the scientific and academic community to evaluate the extent of

the challenges and means to address them. We believe there should be balance between the

provision of crucial services by large satellite constellations the advancement scientific discoveries

in astronomy.

Chair, distinguished delegates,

We recognize that there are areas of this work that could overlap with the responsibilities of the

International Telecommunications Union and we stress that the development of a workplan and

Terms of Reference for an Expert Group should rest firmly within the remit of COPUOS.

Furthermore, Canada considers that a short duration mandate for this expert group could

potentially be insufficient as the scope of the proposed work is significant with a wide-range of

actors that should be involved at the multilateral level. Canada wishes to note that the mandate

of the proposed Expert Group should place emphasis on taking action to develop

recommendations concerning proposed mitigation measures.

Mr. Chair, Distinguished Delegates,

As we noted, we do support the establishment of an Expert Group on Dark and Quiet Skies, as well

as extension of the Temporary Agenda Item, given that the Expert Group on Space Weather

recently concluded its work. However, it is critical that the envisioned Expert Group ensures a fair

and balanced voice between the astronomy community and private satellite operators in order to
