Preparations of the UN Summit of the Future, scheduled for 22-23 September 2024 in New York, will intensify with the release of the Zero Draft of the UN Pact for the Future. Proposals for peaceful and sustainable use of outer space, as well as for maximising the benefits of space for all, are expected to be included in more than one of the chapters. The side event aims to continue the dialogue on the space track of the UN Summit of the Future with representatives of COPUOS Member States, as well as observer organisations. It will provide a platform to present the space-related aspects of the Zero Draft and to exchange preliminary views on the way forward.
