Figure 5. Screenshots from the Web app showing doctor recommendation and content analysis functions.

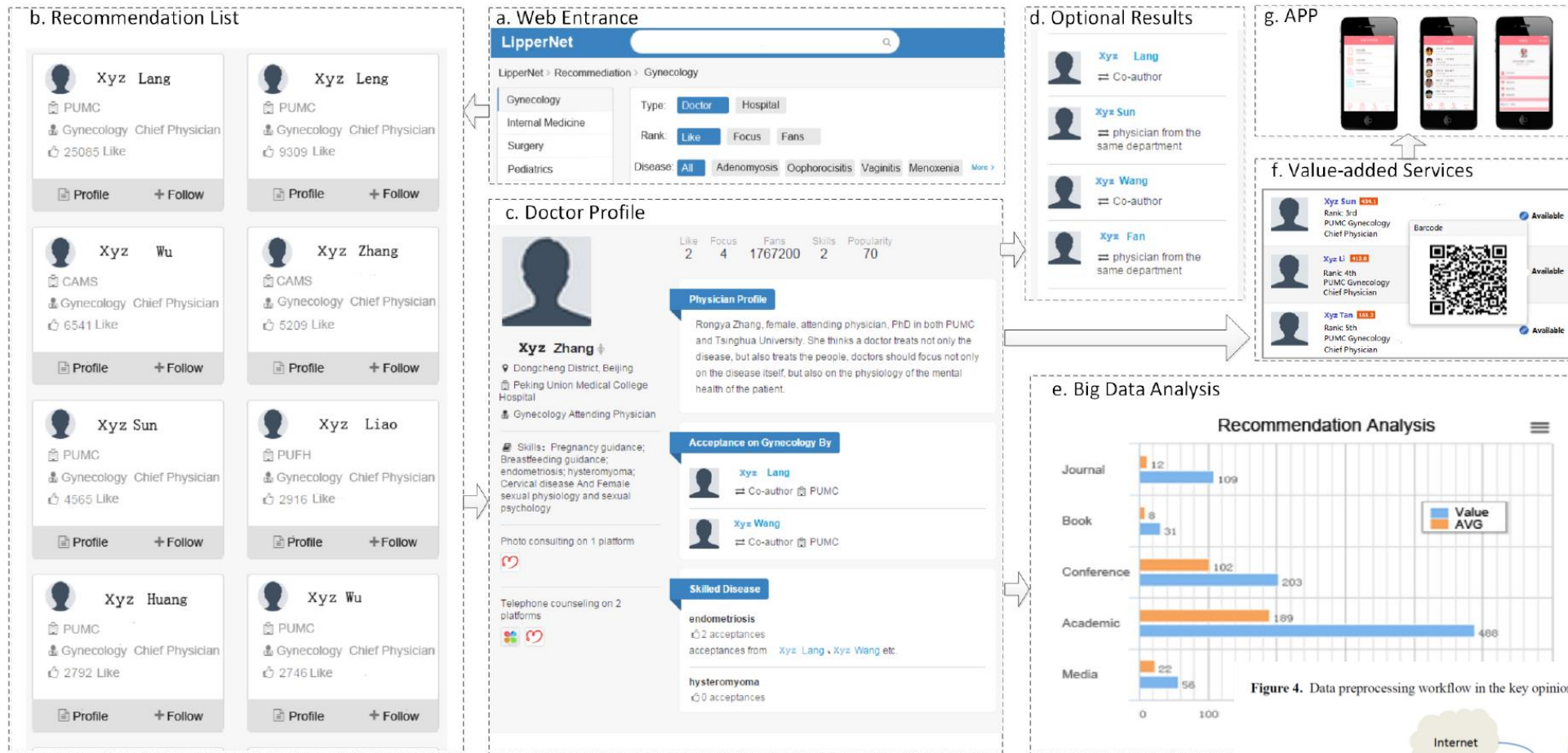
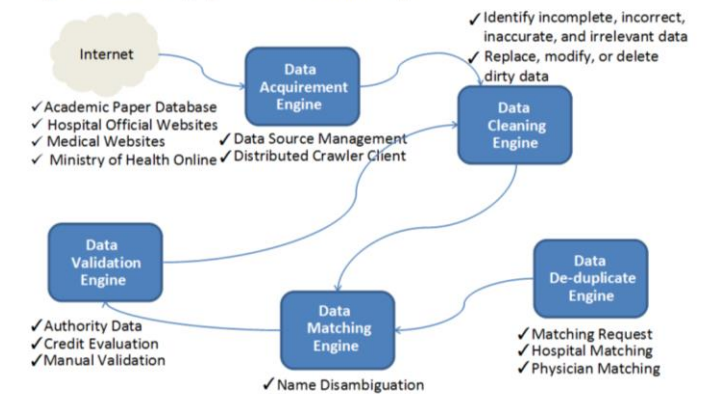


Figure 4. Data preprocessing workflow in the key opinion leader identification system.
