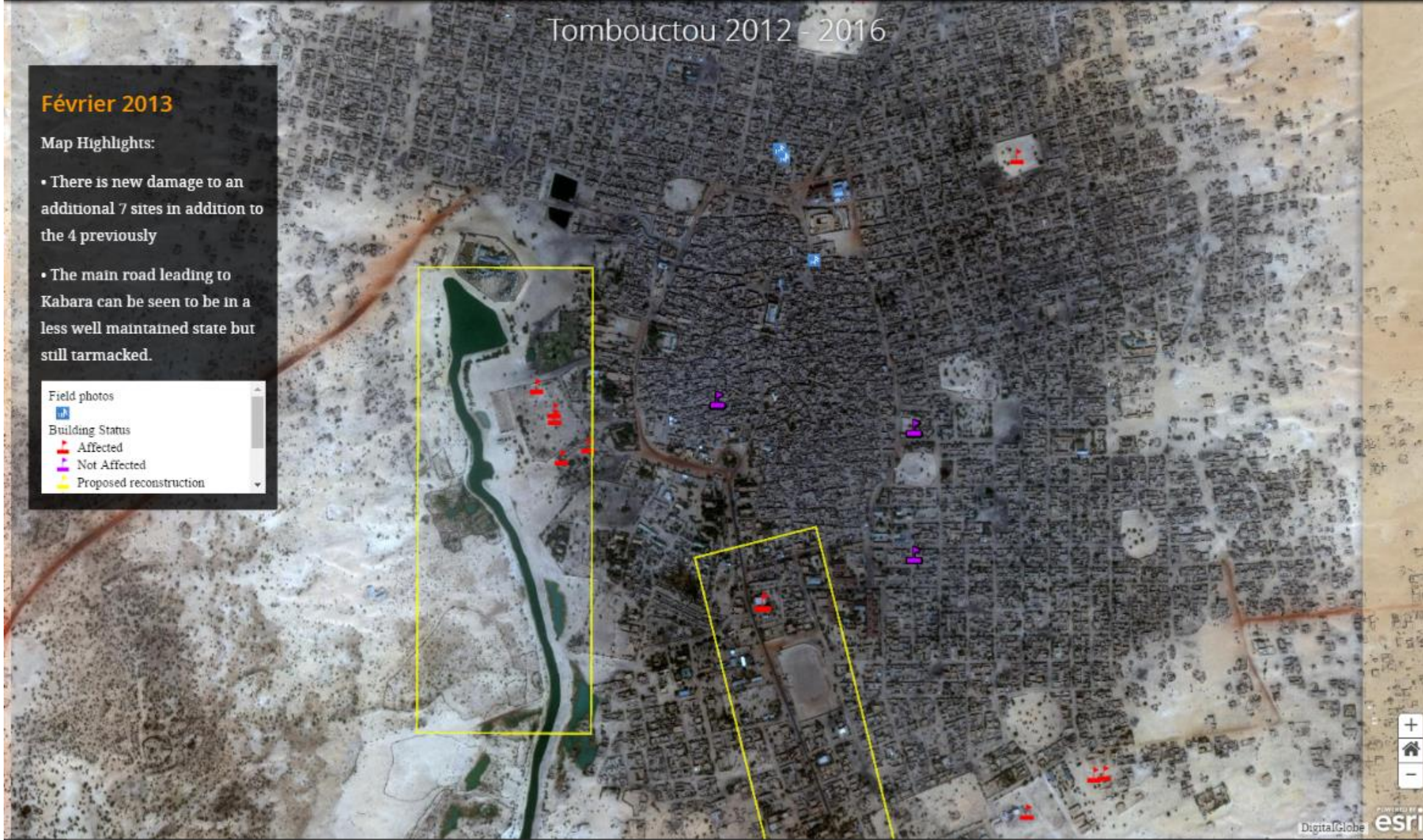

Map Highlights:

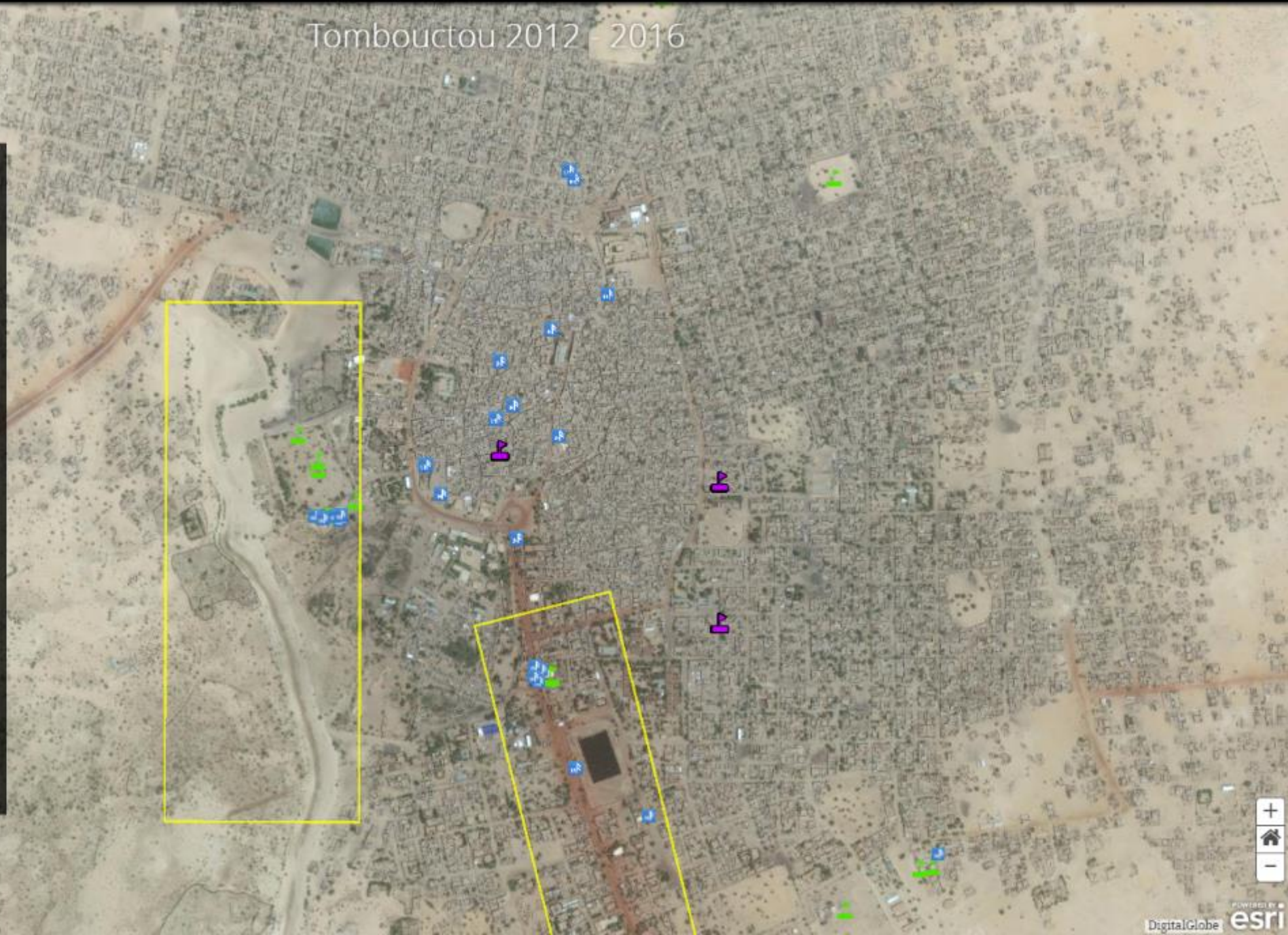
- There is no new visible damage to these sites
