
Reports are now available by members of the public who believe they have experienced a problem with GPS:

- The collection is comprised of reports that are submitted to the US Coast Guard Navigation Center by people who are *civil* and *non-aviation* users of the GPS system.
- Making this information available provides better situational awareness to the public.
- The reports include information, if available, about possible causes or resolutions to problems.
- The website will be updated as new reports are received and processed. All reports made in 2018 are now available. Reports for prior years will be made available in the future.
- Not shared is information about specific manufacturers' equipment, exact locations, or information that can identify specific people or vessels.
