INFORMATION FURNISHED IN CONFORMITY WITH GENERAL ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 1721 B (XVI) BY STATES LAUNCHING OBJECTS INTO ORBIT OR BEYOND

Letter dated 12 September 1962 from the Permanent Representative of the United States of America addressed to the Asting Secretary-General

In accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 1 and 2 of General Assembly resolution 1721 B (XVI), I enclose registration data concerning objects launched into orbit or beyond by the United States. With these additions and deletions in the record, you will have received for the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space and for the Public Registry a complete registry of all United States space vehicles and associated objects in orbit or space transit as of 15 August 1962.

In addition, there is included supplemental information concerning United States space vehicles which were launched between our previous report (as of 31 July 1962) and 15 August 1962 and which achieved orbit but were no longer in orbit as of 12002 on 15 August 1962.
