Letter dated 1 October 1962 from the Permanent Representative of the United States of America addressed to the Acting Secretary-General

In accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 1 and 2 of General Assembly resolution 1721 B (XVI), I enclose registration data concerning objects launched into orbit or beyond by the United States. With these additions and deletions in the record, you will have received for the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space and for the Public Registry a complete registry of all United States space vehicles and associated objects in orbit or space transit as of 31 August 1962.

During the current report period, 16 August through 31 August 1962, no objects were launched by the United States which (1) achieved orbit but were no longer in orbit as of 1200Z on 31 August 1962, or (2) failed to achieve orbit.
