INFORMATION FURNISHED IN CONFORMITY WITH GENERAL ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 1721 B (XVI) BY STATES LAUNCHING OBJECTS INTO ORBIT OR BEYOND

Letter dated 26 March 1964 from the Permanent Representative of the United States of America addressed to the Secretary-General

In accordance with the provision of Part B, paragraphs 1 and 2, of United Nations General Assembly resolution 1721 (XVI), I enclose registration data concerning objects launched into orbit or beyond by the United States. With these additions and deletions to the record Your Excellency will have received for the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space and for the Public Registry a complete registry of all United States space vehicles in orbit or beyond as of 16 February 1964.

The United States launched no vehicles between 31 January and 15 February 1964 which either achieved orbit but were no longer in orbit as of 2400Z on 15 February 1964, or which did not achieve orbit.
