Letter dated 17 July 1964 from the Permanent Representative of the United States of America addressed to the Secretary-General

In accordance with the provision of Part B, paragraphs 1 and 2, of the United Nations General Assembly resolution 1721 (XVI), I enclose registration data concerning objects launched into orbit or beyond by the United States. With this addition and deletion to the record Your Excellency will have received for the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space and for the Public Registry a complete registry of all United States space vehicles in orbit or beyond as of 31 May 1964.

In addition there is included supplemental information concerning a United States space vehicle which was launched on 19 May 1964 and which achieved orbit but was no longer in orbit as of 2400Z on 31 May 1964.
